CHARTER AMENDMENT #1

ARTICLE III, SECTION 3.06 labeled "Mayor and Council Chair Person" to provide the chairperson when serving in the Mayor's absence has no power of veto and eliminating the word "sole" from the section on duties;

ARTICLE IV, SECTION 4.07 labeled "Mayor's Absence or Inability to Serve" to provide the Council Chairperson serving in the Mayor's absence does not have the power to veto and clarify duties of the chairperson when so acting.

ARTICLE III, SECTION 3.02 labeled "City Council" to require City Council adopt an ordinance on City's purchasing policies.
